April 25, 2022

Monthly Board Meeting was called to order by President Worlow at 7pm, on Monday, April 25, 2022. Meeting was held at Village Hall, 309 S 2nd St., San Jose, IL. Roll call taken, present: Allen, Cross, Nolan, Price, 4 present, 1 absent Tillquist. Also, in attendance: President Worlow, Clerk Custodio, Maintenance Larmore, Treasurer Shelley.

President Worlow asked for approval of Consent Agenda, Trustee Allen made motion to approve Consent Agenda, 2nd Trustee Nolan, roll call: Allen yea; Cross yea; Nolan yea; Price yea; 4 yeas, 0 nays.

Maintenance:

Buildings & Grounds:

Garage located at water tower park is in need of repair, Trustee Cross will get estimates for siding repair.

Step repair by Village Hall garage entrance will begin soon.

Streets & Alleys:

Trustee Price informed the board that she cleaned up broken toys, batteries, screws and bolts from the roadway in Furlane.

Health & Safety:

Town-wide clean up set for May 21st, 8am to noon, no tires, no electronics, no large appliances.

Trustee Nolan voiced concern about large number of stray cats in the vicinity of Locust and N. 1st St. Trustee Nolan will look into getting the cats trapped and taken to Logan County Animal Control.
