

Village of San Jose
Water Committee Meeting
August 29, 2023

Water Committee Meeting was called to order by President Worlow at 6:00pm, on Thursday, August 29, 2023. Meeting was held at Village Hall, 309 S 2nd Street San Jose, Illinois. Roll call taken: Present: Allen; Price and Blackstock – 3 Trustees present. Also, in attendance: President Worlow, Kim Albers and Clerk Shelley. Meeting agenda was posted more than forty-eight in advance on the village website, outside and inside bulletin boards at Village Hall and is attached to and made part of the minutes.

WATER COMMITTEE:

Trustee Allen discussed water forgiveness for LeBron. Water forgiveness policy does not specifically address outside faucets. Clerk Shelley agreed to add outside faucets to the first section of the Water and Sewer Adjustment policy. The committee agreed to adjust sewer by 50%, no adjustment for water and LeBron will pay additional \$40 over typical monthly bill. In the future, residents must complete all portions of the form to request water forgiveness including narrative portion. The committee also requested Clerk Shelley add to #1 under inside leaks a note that no forgiveness will be granted until reviewed by Water Committee.

Clerk Shelley stated she could not find an ordinance that required homeowners to have water service. Mayor Worlow agreed to look into the matter as he thought an ordinance existed.

NEW BUSINESS:

Kim Albers discussed his tentative plans to retire in the next year or so. He has spoken to people who he believes are able to maintain the infrastructure. Additional discussion is planned for a later date.

Motion to adjourn at 6:43 pm by Trustee Price and seconded by Trustee Blackstock, unanimous approval. Motion carries.
