Police Committee Meeting  
March 18, 2024

Police Committee Meeting was called to order by President Worlow at 6:00 pm, on Monday, March 28, 2024. Meeting was held at Village Hall, 309 S 2<sup>nd</sup> Street San Jose, Illinois. Roll call taken: Present: Price, Blackstock and Nolan – 3 Trustees present. Also, in attendance: President Worlow and Clerk Shelley. Meeting agenda was posted more than forty-eight in advance on the village website, outside and inside bulletin boards at Village Hall and is attached to and made part of the minutes.

**POLICE COMMITTEE:**

Trustee Price discussed responsibilities of committee members and temporary chief Worlow. Worlow will continue to file crime reports. No other trustees were assigned job tasks.

Trustee Price wants to keep maintenance on both police vehicles. This includes fixing tires and oil changes.

Trustee Price discussed a citizen's complaint with Mason County Sheriff's office. Trustee Price is concerned that there is no ordinance officer and is contemplating hiring a previously employed ordinance officer. Mason County Sheriff stated this is an ordinance violation and the village should pursue it. Clerk Shelley agreed to send an email to the village attorney asking if an ordinance officer could be hired without a police chief.

Mayor Worlow stated he will check on the Illinois Law Enforcement Training & Standard Board Forms.

The Police radios have not been programmed.

Motion to adjourn at 6:34 pm by Trustee Price, unanimous approval. Motion carries.
