

Village of San Jose Board Meeting

May 20, 2024

Monthly Board Meeting was called to order by President Worlow at 7pm, on Monday, May 20, 2024. Meeting was held at Village Hall, 309 S 2<sup>nd</sup> St., San Jose, IL. Roll call taken, present: Allen, Blackstock, Cross, Tillquist and Nolan – 5 were present. Also, in attendance: President Worlow, Clerk Shelley and citizens John Carey and Delayne Durdle. President Worlow asked for approval of Consent Agenda, Trustee Allen made motion to approve Consent Agenda, 2<sup>nd</sup> Trustee Tillquist, roll call: Allen yea; Blackstock yea; Cross yea; Tillquist yea and Nolan yea. 5 yeas, 0 nays.

**Citizen's Concerns:**

Delayne Durdle stated his position on the property line between Allen's Grove Township property and his farmland. He believes part of the access to the lagoons is on his property and he is not pleased with the number of vehicles that drove on his property and compacted the soil. Mr. Durdle offered to pay half of any surveys fees to determine the legal property line. Adverse possession was discussed but no firm decision was made. Mr. Durdle would like the rock removed from his property. President Worlow took note of the request. Trustee Tillquist and Clerk Shelley plan on going to Mason County Recorder's office on Tuesday to review parcel tracts.

**President:**

**Clerk:**

Clerk Shelley corrected her statement regarding temporary turn on of water without active service. Water is only temporarily turned on if a citizen plans to activate service and can pay for the interim water.

Clerk Shelley advised she will begin posting on the official village Facebook page when maintenance plans to fog for mosquitoes.

Clerk Shelley recommended Trustees and Mayor read the "Social Media Use by Government Officials" in the May 2024 IML Magazine.

Trustee Allen made a motion to approve Ordinance 24-007, Compensation for Elected Officials, seconded by Cross. Roll call: Allen yea; Blackstock yea; Cross yea; Tillquist yea and Nolan yea. 5 yeas, 0 nays.

**Engineer:**

Trustee Allen made a motion to pay bills, 2<sup>nd</sup> Trustee Tillquist. Roll call: Allen yea; Blackstock yea; Cross yea; Tillquist yea and Nolan yea. 5 yeas, 0 nays.

Trustee Allen made a motion to purchase a refrigerator for the Lodge, 2<sup>nd</sup> Trustee Blackstock. Allen yea; Blackstock yea; Cross yea; Tillquist yea and Nolan yea. 5 yeas, 0 nays.

Trustee Allen provided update on sewer problem at 11 Furlane Drive. She is waiting for detailed documents from the homeowner before submitting an insurance claim. Mayor Worlow stated the homeowner should consider purchasing a backwater valve to prevent future problems.

**Unfinished Business:**

Ordinance violation for Hedrick has been resolved. McGinnis and Stuff continue to be pursued by the Village attorney.

Ballard noise complaint was removed from unfinished business until the Village hired a Police Chief or Ordinance Officer.

Clerk Shelley advised the mortgage company for Sarver ordinance violation is aware of the need for a fence.

Since an ordinance already exists regarding trash cans, a notice will be included with the June water bills stating all trash cans must be removed from the curb/road within 24 hours after pickup.

**New Business:**

Mayor Worlow stated the air conditioning was not working at the Lodge and the refrigerator was not working properly and Hernan's has been contacted.

The meeting closed at 7:30 and will be reconvened on Wednesday, May 22, 2024 at 6:30 pm.

The meeting reconvened on Wednesday, May 22, 2024, at 6:31. Trustee Tillquist presented information gathered at Mason County Recorder's Office. Clerk Shelley discussed pricing received from two different surveyors. Trustee Tillquist made a motion to approve ~\$2,500 in surveying fees to Joe Tate and seconded by Trustee Allen. Allen yea; Blackstock yea; Cross yea; Tillquist yea and Nolan yea. 5 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

Trustee Allen made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:36 pm with unanimous approval.
