

Village of San Jose
Emergency Special Board Meeting
December 13, 2021

An Emergency Special Board Meeting was called to order by President Worlow at 6pm, on Monday, December 13, 2021. Meeting was held at Village Hall, 309 S 2nd Street San Jose, Illinois. Roll call taken: Present: Allen; Cross; Custodio; Nolan; Price; 5 present. Also, in attendance: President Worlow, Clerk Custodio, Treasurer Shelley. Emergency Special Board Meeting agenda was posted twenty-fours in advance on the village website, outside and inside bulletin boards at Village Hall and is attached to and made part of the minutes. Trustee Custodio, with Trustees Price and Allen in agreement called for this emergency special board meeting, following 5ILCS 120/2.02 and Village Code 1-5-4B.

Trustee Custodio stated that he called for this meeting due to concerns about the sale of village property, without the approval of the board. President Worlow stated that after the November 15, 2021 board meeting, Chief Binegar asked President Worlow and Police Chair Nolan about selling items within the police department and they gave him verbal approval to do so. There was discussion about the lack of communication to the police committee members and board members about the approval to sell equipment.

Trustee Allen asked Police Chair Nolan to call a Police Committee meeting on Monday, December 20th at 6pm.

At 6:44pm Trustee Allen made a motion to go into closed session per 5ILCS 120/2(c)(1), 2nd by discussion, roll call: Allen yea; Cross yea; Custodio yea; Nolan yea; Price yea; motion carried.

At 6:55pm Trustee Allen made motion to return to open meeting, 2nd Trustee Price, roll call: Allen yea; Cross yea; Custodio yea; Nolan yea; Price yea; motion carried.

Trustee Allen will be making the following recommendations at the December 20, 2021 Board meeting:
Clerk Custodio will prepare a memo will be given to all village employees and posted inside and outside village hall, stating that 'effective immediately, loitering will no longer be allowed in Village Hall, please do your business and promptly leave the building'.

Village code enforcement will become the responsibility of Chief Binegar effective January 1, 2022.

Motion to adjourn meeting at 7pm by Trustee Allen, 2nd discussion.

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
