Police Committee Meeting  
February 27, 2023

Police Committee Meeting was called to order by President Worlow at 6:00pm, on Monday, February 27, 2023. Meeting was held at Village Hall, 309 S 2<sup>nd</sup> Street San Jose, Illinois. Roll call taken: Present: Allen; Nolan and Price - 5 present. Also, in attendance: President Worlow, Clerk Shelley, Chief Smith and resident Mike McGinnis. Meeting agenda was posted more than forty-eight in advance on the village website, outside and inside bulletin boards at Village Hall and is attached to and made part of the minutes.

**Citizen's Concerns:**

Citizen McGinnis had no comments.

**POLICE:**

Chief Smith agreed to be the Police FOIA Officer, and he is aware of training requirements.

Members discussed livestock and poultry restrictions in village limits. Mayor Worlow stated that any residents with livestock or poultry would be written an ordinance violation. Chief Smith attempted to explain to McGinnis the reason for his future ordinance violation. Committee members advised Chief Smith to issue an ordinance immediately.

Committee members agree to pay part time officers at least \$18.00 per hour or possibly more if their experience merits a higher starting salary. Chief Smith will post for part time officer.

Chief Smith was reminded he must work 70 hours per pay period to drive the white police car to and from work. Chief Smith will provide his work hours to Mayor and Committee Chairperson. If residents call village hall asking for the Chief, employees should direct residents to 309-247-1234. If Chief Smith is not in office, the call will forward to Mason County Sheriff's office.

Chief Smith discussed police report filed by village employee. He advised village employee has 18 months to file charges. Committee agreed that village employees will not go onto hostile residents property without police backup.

Motion to adjourn at 6:40 pm by Trustee Allen, seconded by Trustee Price. Allen aye, Price aye and Nolan aye. Motion carries.
