CLOSED SESSION SPECIAL BOARD MEETING
FEBRUARY 7, 2022

Entered closed session per 5ILCS 120/2 (2) @ 7:30pm.

Trustee Allen voiced following concerns about Chief Binegar:

Removes time cards from time card slot in village hall and takes them with him; he has reported that he has been in traffic court, at a time when court is not in session; takes home the SUV, the Impala is the vehicle that was agreed upon to be his take home car; Mason County State's Attorney returned a citation that was misfiled with them, should have been filed in Logan County.

Trustee Price is concerned that Chief Binegar has been asked to follow certain rules/protocol, yet he continues to push against following them.

Discussion regarding duties of Village Clerk in the Village Code Book and statement of wages for Village Clerk and Village Treasurer in the Code Book. Trustee Nolan recommended ordinance to amend Village Code, omitting wages of Village Clerk and Village Treasurer from the code and omitting 1-6A-1 A #4 and 1-6A-1 C #C.

Village President Worlow stated that he will be reviewing all timecards prior to payroll, will give them to treasurer, for checks to be ready on Friday afternoon, every 2 weeks.

Trustee Allen made motion to return to open meeting at 8:14pm, 2nd Trustee Cross, roll call: Allen yea; Cross yea; Custodio yea; Nolan yea; Price yea; Tillquist absent; motion carried 5 yeas.
