Discussion:

102 N 1st St. and 213 W Race St. – have village attorney take to court, seeking remedy of building being demolished at expense of property owner.

309 W Vine St. – letter will be sent to property owner giving notice that he is to repair or remove shed.

406 N 1st St. mobile home – Trustee Skelton will get update from his uncle as to where in the process they are of removing mobile home from this address.

RV ordinance – reviewed ordinances from several cities in the area and made suggestions for ordinance to be voted on at December 17, 2018 meeting.

617 S 2nd St. – Clerk to write a letter regarding anticipated timeline of demolition of property destroyed in fire.

Committee recommendations for the September 17, 2018 Board meeting:

1. Village Attorney Pat McGrath start court process, seeking remedy of properties being demolished at expense of property owner.
