President Worlow asked for approval of Consent Agenda, Trustee Allen made motion to approve Consent Agenda, 2nd Trustee Price, roll call: Allen yea; Cross yea; Nolan yea; Price yea; Tillquist yea. 5 yeas, 0 nays.

Citizen's Concerns:

Buildings & Grounds:

Trustee Cross reported that materials have been purchased to repair the village shed/garage located at corner of 1st & Vine St., work to be completed in the fall

Streets & Alleys:

Sidewalk on north side of RT 136 and 4th St., where property burned down needs to be repaired. Seal coat work will start in late July

Health & Safety:

Village will spray for Poisonous Hemlock that is on village property.
