May 20, 2022

Monthly Board Meeting was called to order by President Worlow at 7pm, on Monday, May 20, 2022. Meeting was held at Village Hall, 309 S 2nd St., San Jose, IL. Roll call taken, present: Allen, Blackstock, Cross, Nolan, Price, 5 present, 1 absent Tillquist. Also, in attendance: President Worlow, Clerk Custodio, Maintenance Larmore, Treasurer Shelley, Water Superintendent Albers, Mike Burris.

Maintenance:

Larmore reported that he will be cleaning edges of the roads and spraying weed killer around the San Jose signs at east and west edge of town.

Water, Sewer & Garbage:

Tentative start date of mid-June for the lift station on Walnut St.

M. Burriss and Water Superintendent Albers looked at village infrastructure and came up with 5-year and 3-year possible work/repair list. 5 years: clean and paint the water tower. 3 years: pull and inspect for cleaning wells #5 and #4. Discussed sludge in lagoon. Burriss or Engineer Desplinter will write an appropriations grant from Rep. Lahood's office, for the main pump station, possible cost of \$400,000.00.

ISO inspection to be completed 5/23/22, includes rating fire department, water department, size of water mains number of water hydrants. This is done for insurance company ratings.

Police:

Chief Smith submitted the following report: Assisted Mason County Sheriff's Office with death investigation; 2 citations issued for inoperable vehicles; 5 notices issued for weed/grass violations; 1 notice issued for inoperable vehicle violation; 1 notice issued for litter/tires violation; Federal LESO Program application approved; Fines & Fees received \$84.

Chief Smith's last day as full-time officer in a different community is May 30, 2022, after this Smith plans to work more hours in San Jose. D. Marlo will do ordinance writing at \$25.00 per hour.

Trustee Allen made motion, 2nd Trustee Nolan to adopt Ordinance 22-573 making amendments regarding vehicle impoundments to Title 6 of the Village Code, roll call: Allen yea; Blackstock yea; Cross yea; Nolan yea; Price yea; 5 yeas, 0 nays.

Buildings & Grounds:

J. Canada no longer cleaning village buildings, Trustee Nolan will reach out to several people regarding cleaning buildings.

Trustee Cross reported that he and his wife will donate the cost of repair to the village shed/garage located at corner of 1st & Vine St.

President Worlow will talk with homeowner of 101 Furlane and clarify with him questions regarding road work and flow of water.

Trustee Allen made motion, 2nd Trustee Cross to approve the following recommendations from Closed Session:

Advertise for a full-time maintenance worker, hourly compensation of \$15.00 to \$17.00 based on experience.

Have D. Burris update the village map.

Increase wages: Maintenance workers M. Hammel and P. Hancock to \$14.00 per hour; Water Clerk L. Karker to \$15.50 per hour; Water Superintendent K. Albers base salary by \$100.00; Treasurer Shelley base salary by \$100.00; Mosquito Spraying to \$75.00 per time spraying village. Wage increase goes into effect on May 16, 2022.
