October 19, 2020

September monthly Board Meeting was called to order by President Worlow at 7:00pm, on Monday, October 19, 2020. Meeting was held at Village Hall, 309 S 2nd Street San Jose, Illinois. Strong Communities Program Grant – Mike Burris:

Consultant Burris reported that total grant amount available is \$82,900.00; properties projected for grant program, 2 on First Street for demo, 1 on Race Street for demo, 1 on Main Street to be redone; Village doesn't currently have a vacant property register of a revitalization plan, both are needed; Trustee Nolan made motion to have M. Burris continue with program, completing the necessary steps, 2nd Trustee Allen, roll call vote: Allen yea; Blackstock yea; Nolan yea; Skelton yea; Tillquist yea; Williams yea; carried 6 yeas.
