February 12, 2022

Police Committee of the Village of San Jose called to order by Village President Worlow at 6pm, with Police Chair Nolan, Committee members Price and Allen present. Also present was Village Clerk Custodio, Police Chief Binegar.

Trustee Allen asked Chief Binegar for clarification as to court on 1/21/22, was it for a case involving the village? Binegar stated it was in Tazewell County and not involving San Jose. Trustee Price asked if Binegar was clocked in with San Jose and used San Jose squad car for transportation to and from court, Binegar's answer was yes to both questions. Trustee Allen reminded Binegar that no overtime has been authorized. President Worlow reminded Binegar that Ford SUV squad car is not to be used as he's take-home car, only the Chevy Impala. Binegar stated that Impala was in the shop being worked on when he used Ford as take-home vehicle.

Binegar asked to change combination code on department door, only police and mayor have access; access to the security cameras; having credit card in his name
